VIN DE PAYS DU GARD

Long known for producing the most wine of France's many regions, Languedoc now attracts attention for high quality, affordable reds. This Vin de Pays du Gard is a good example of the fruity, well balanced red wines being made there. A classic table wine with juicy, ripe fruit and that French character that says "je ne sais quois". Certified organically grown by Ecocert, it blends several rhone varietals including: Syrah, Mourvedre, Merlot, Alicante and Carignan. It will remind you of that table wine you found in a local bistro and wanted to bring home from your last trip to southern France.

Jacques Frelin is a central figure in French organic viticulture. His family owns Chateau du Moulin de Peyronin in Bordeaux and Domaine de Clairac in Languedoc. Jacques also sells the wines of many other organic estates in southern France and works for National Union of Independent Agrobiologists, U.N.I.A. His high quality wines continue to receive awards in France and the U.S.

This wine is an excellent value. The structure and spicy flavors complement many meat and pasta dishes. Its easy, drinkable style will win over any lover of Mediterranean food and wine.
