Hohen-Sülzen is situated in the so called Eisbachtal. The Eisbach is an upland stream that springs in the Donnersberg Massive, supplies the Hohen-Sülzen valley with cool, night air. Because of this, grapes ripen slowly in spite of high temperatures, and vital acidity does not evaporate.

In this Riesling, the nose is dominant of really ripe aromas of sweet peaches and apricots. On the palate, the fruit aromas are combined with earthy notes: Tabaco, herbs, licorice. This perfect match of fruit and stone is really characteristic for the wines from Hohen-Sülzen: Cool soil and warm fruit.
