TASTING NOTES

Aromas of boysenberry pie topped with vanilla cream and sprinkled with nutmeg. Blackberries and licorice linger and pop in the broad, lush finish. Abundant flavors at an incredible value.

27% Coyote Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, Wahluke Slope
26% Rivercrest Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley
10% Cougar Vineyard Syrah, Wahluke Slope
10% Pleasant Vineyard Syrah, Yakima Valley

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The winemaking team does not want people to feel as though they are "settling" for a box of Cabernet Sauvignon. After winning numerous accolades for the previous vintages our goal was to surpass the quality of those wines. With the terrific concentration of the red wines in the 2007 vintage, we feel like we accomplished that feat. Goose Ridge has been a major component in the past, and this wine was built around it. Nearly equal measures of Coyote Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon (a warm site) and Rivercrest (the coolest site Cabernet Sauvignon we harvest) provide the broad spectrum of flavors offered by Washington Cabernet based wines. The syrah components sweetened the fruit character and added depth to the blend. A kiss of oak softened the finish and elevated the vanilla and caramel dynamics. Versatile, approachable and a great complement to food.
