Why it's important:

I have never met anyone who doesn't love this wine, plus it's certified as made with organically grown grapes, and it's *Biodynamic* as well.

Long-established organic vineyards produce healthier, better-tasting grapes

- Newer organic vineyards don't produce the quality or consistency of older ones
- Guy Bossard is revered internationally for the quality of his Muscadet
- The Bossard family has made this wine for generations
- Grapes are fertilized and protected from pests naturally – no synthetics
- Estate vineyards are farmed biodynamically – treated as a living organism
- Fermented “sur lie” (“on the yeast”) to impart fuller flavor and slight effervescence

Grapes: 100% Melon de Bourgogne

Region of origin: Sèvre et Maine district, Loire Valley, FR

Taste: Very dry and refreshing, with stone fruit and citrus flavors

Pairing: Clams, mussels, oysters, chicken and other salads
