

*Domaine du Petit Coteau*  
*Vouvray Sec*  
*“Les Grenouilles”*

Situated between the village of Vernou and the village of Chancay, the Petit Coteau vineyard is very close to the Loire with good sun exposure and ideal temperature variations between day and night. The vines are 20-45 years old and the soil is mostly clay and calcareous ~ known locally as Tuffeau. This is a special type of soft limestone imparting its own distinctive “terroir” and ensuring good drainage down the slopes and keeping the soil warm at night. Vouvray achieved its own appellation in 1936 and is the largest appellation in the Loire.




**TASTING NOTES:**

Deep, full flavors of peach, melon and quince are ripe and forward until the finish, when firm acidity binds up all the fleshy fruit and leaves it feeling taut and focused.
