Tasting

This is a hearty red with a smooth, dark chocolate finish. At **Petit Roubié** the tannat grape produces quite a powerful, dark wine with plenty of tannic structure, yet with enough ripe fruit to balance the palate. Great value and a good partner for more hearty dishes: meats, stews, pizza.



Technical Aspects

Varietal: Tannat

Alcohol: 12%

Appellation: IGP Pays d'Hérault

Soil: Chalky clay

Harvest: Mechanical, harvested at night to preserve acidity in the grapes.

Yield: 60 hl/ha; average age of vines is 14 yrs. Organic since 1985.

Vinification: Systematic destemming

- Cold clarification
- Thermo- regulated fermentation
- Selected yeast
